Adazi Free Waldorf School (AFWS)

Adazi Free Waldorf School (AFWS) is one of more than a thousand schools in the world that carries out Steiner/Waldorf curriculum and is a part of a strong educational network. It is located in a small town called Adazi which is 25 km away from Riga.

The school was founded by the parents and teachers' general meeting on 1 September 1993. It started with the first three classes and a kindergarten group.

From a group of about 60 children the school has grown into a recognizable and serious educational institution with pupils from the age of 3 to 18.

Nowadays, AFWS has 52 children in the kindergarten, 420 students in primary and secondary school and there are 85 teachers and administration staff. The organisation's main activity is ensuring Steiner/Waldorf education for pupils from the age of 3 to 18.
