

## **Ferenc Földes Grammar School**

Ferenc Földes Grammar School is a highly prestigious secondary school in Miskolc, in the northeast part of Hungary.

The school has a history of more than 450 years. It was named after Ferenc Földes in 1953 and the name has become a real trademark for our school.

The school is ideally located in the city centre. The main building was built in 1911 but the increasing number of students made it necessary to expand it. The new wing – which contains a big library, language rooms and a modern, well-equipped gym - was opened in 2004. A modern science laboratory was also created in 2014.

We are well-known for our 4-year classes specialised in Biology, Chemistry, Mathematics and Physics and also for our 5-year language preparatory classes in English, as well as our 6-year classes with a special curriculum. Our students take part in a lot of national and international competitions every year with a lot of success. We also started AJTP classes for talented but underprivileged students in 2000.

There is a considerable number of traditions and events, which enrich our school life; the Newcomers' Day, the Student Headmaster's Election Days, the Open Days, the Christmas Party, the Földes Ball, the Cultural Day and the School Farewell Ceremony, to name but a few. Our ski camp attracts several students every year and we have been taking part in the Model European Parliament programme for a couple of years. We are also proud members of the European Youth Forum Trogen.
