Liceo Ginnasio Statale G.B. Brocchi is a grammar school founded in 1819. Since then, it has been innovating its educational offer and teaching methods.

Our school is situated in Bassano del Grappa, a little town in the north-east of Italy, not far from Venice. Attended by almost 2,000 students, it is one of the largest schools in the area. Students can specialize in six different courses: classical studies, scientific and applied science courses, social studies, modern languages and socio-economics.

Developing personal, social and civic competencies has always been a priority at Liceo Brocchi. Various projects have been run so far, both curricular and extracurricular (e.g. Social Day, MEP, YPAC, European projects, once called 'Comenius' and 'Leonardo', now 'Erasmus+'). Moreover, courses to get language certifications in English, German, French and Spanish are annually organized.
